\$14 million Landcare Led Bushfire Recovery Grants Program

The National Landcare Network and Landcare Australia, welcome the support announced today by the Australian Government and the National Bushfire Recovery Fund, of the \$14million Landcare Led Bushfire Recovery Grants Program funding going in regions severely impacted by the Black Summer Bushfires of 2019/2020.

Among the 111 bushfire recovery projects supported, activities include training to help communities monitor and recover critical mangrove habitat in South Coast NSW, the restoration of Macquarie Perch habitat in Alpine waterways and helping Greater and Yellow-bellied Gliders near Noosa.

Managing the delivery of the program, Landcare Australia and the National Landcare Network will work in partnership with State and Territory Landcare peak bodies to deliver programmes across some of the worst bushfire-impacted areas, ranging from the east coast of South East Queensland, the NSW north and south coasts, the World Heritage listed Greater Blue Mountains, Australia's alpine areas, East Gippsland and Kangaroo Island.
